ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL CORPORATION - Conclusion of Durability Testing on 4-Stroke at Carnot Emission Services

Environmental Control Corporation (OTCBB: EVCC) - is pleased to announce that durability testing on a Honda four-stroke engine equipped with EVCC's catalytic muffler has concluded at Carnot Emission Services (CES) in San Antonio, TX. The preliminary report has been released, and management at EVCC is pleased with the results. The report indicates that EVCC's catalytic muffler not only endured the 125 hour useful life of this engine category, it achieved reductions in Total Hydrocarbons (THC), Oxides of Nitrogen (NOx) and Carbon Monoxide (CO) that exceeded our expectations.

EVCC's catalytic muffler was fitted to a Honda four-stroke 163cc engine as used in a lawn-mowers and other lawn and garden equipment. A 125 hour durability test (in accordance with US EPA and CARB regulations) was performed by officials at CES, and the preliminary report showed the following emission levels in comparison with the Original Engine Manufactured (OEM) muffler:

As shown above, when using the original engine manufactured (OEM) muffler, this particular engine does not meet the 2007 emission standards recently announced by CARB. When outfitted with EVCC's catalytic muffler, however, this engine meets both CARB and EPA emission standards.

Glenn Knight, Chief Scientific Officer of EVCC, says "We have been aware of our durability capabilities (through internal field tests) for quite some time. Nonetheless, having a professionally-administered durability test demonstrate such strong results is truly a great accomplishment. We are proud to share these latest test results with our potential clients".

The complete test report is currently being prepared by CES, and will be posted on EVCC's website (www.econtrolcorp.com) as soon as it becomes available.
